

Headquartered in Daytona Beach, Florida, the LPGA Tour maintains a strong focus on charity through its tournaments, its grassroots junior and women's programs and its LPGA Foundation.





THE LASTING LEGACY...

In 2025, the largest donation in the history of the CPKC Women's Open was made with a \$4 million donation to the Hamilton Health Sciences Foundation/MacKids and \$502,000 to the Trillium Health Foundation.

In addition to the \$4.5 million raised during the 2025 CPKC Women's Open in Mississauga, the CPKC Has Heart campaign has left a lasting impact in all communities the CPKC Women's Open has been played in support of children's heart health:




